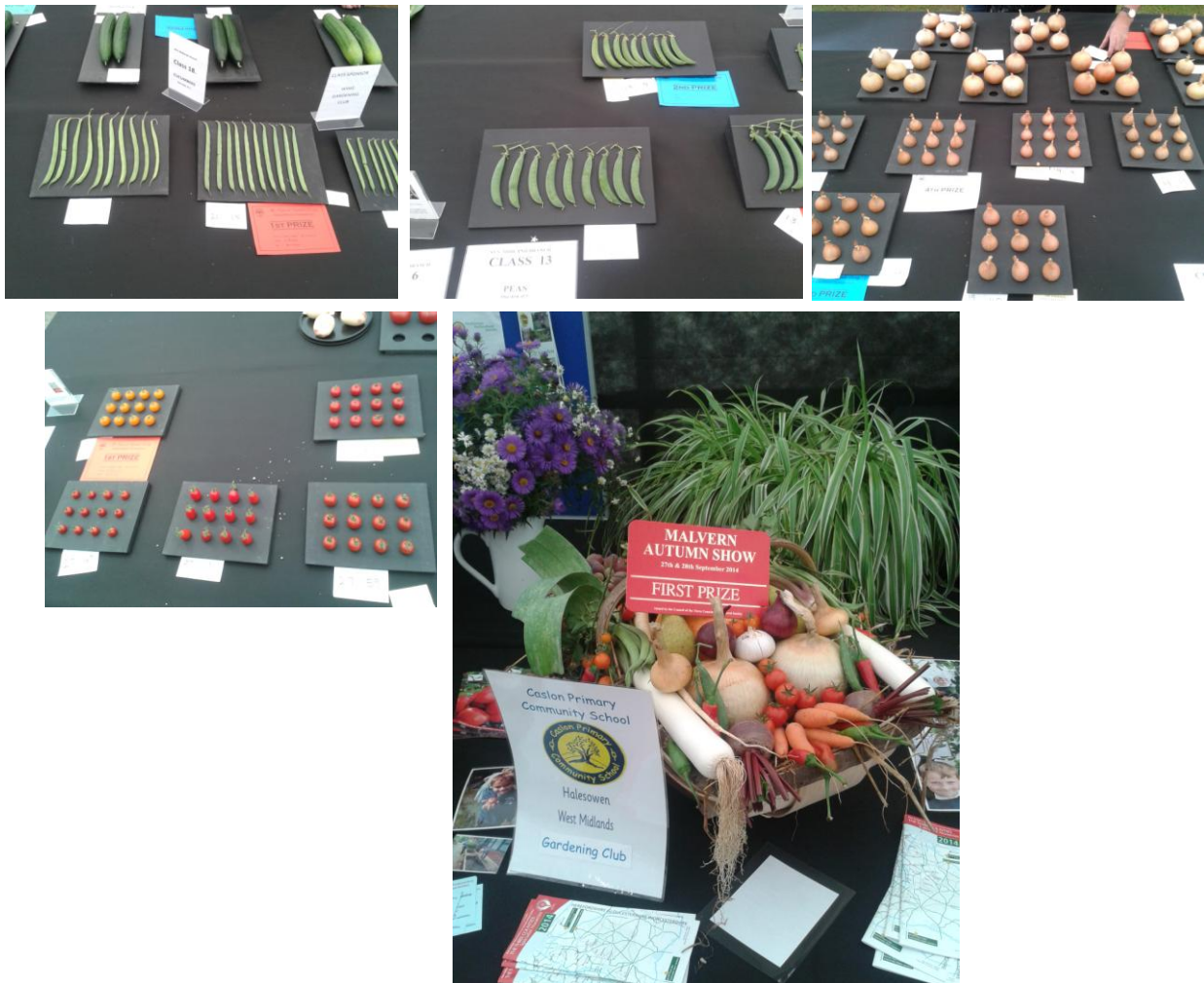


Malvern Autumn Show: I did my talk on the Saturday morning at 11am and it was a full house...and it went down well
