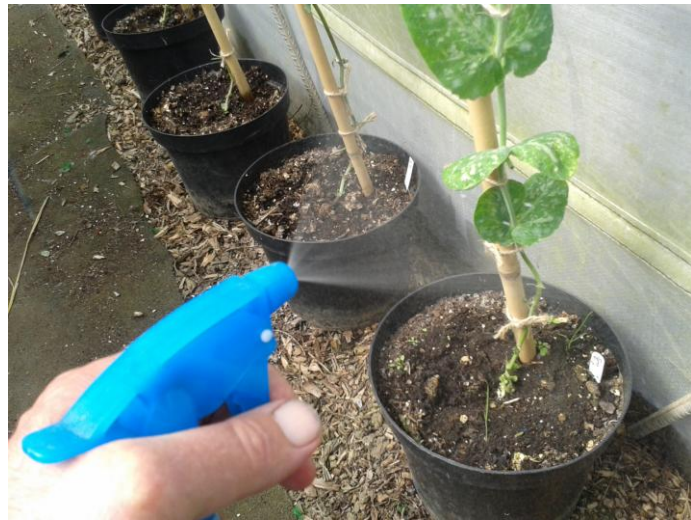


Peas in tunnel now have the 1st signs of mildew on the bottom leaf

This works for mildew on my fruit so trialling it on my peas this year!



All the lower, infected leaves are cut off and binned and the rest of the leaves up to the 1st pea are sprayed again keeping away from the pods



Straw now mulched around peas

Dwarf beans and peas done







Spray working, i.e. a sign of mildew on the 4th leaf up but not on the leaves I've sprayed – so, I will keep you up to date

If you don't spray your toms look out for rag worts under the leaves



Had these pansies from the Dorset Show (£10), mycorrhizae underneath again as I've just taken out last year's winter pansies using it!



A good watering every min, 4 dollops!



2 days later - standing up



Had another load of used scaffolding boards delivered. £5 for a 13ft board - ideal for raised beds...soon all our site will be raised beds!



The moles are back again so I'm feeding him moth balls (from the pound shop)

And I'm now using 1.5 bottles of piddle a day to keep the badger at bay – it's working though!
