

Had a pigeon in my fruit cage during the week, time to put the top net on!

Straining wires put up first (less sagging)



Net cut with an overlap! 2 corners secured first, bail of string tied to middle and thrown over 'tuther side

All pulled tight and secured



Job done in just over an hour, top net will come off before the onset of winter

Grape vines in the tunnel on the plot need jobbing!



My first thinning out

Every other one is taken out



The remaining stems are pruned to one leaf after the grapes!

The main stem from the ground, all growth is taken off



All onions now out on the plot...large, Toughball and shallots, all strawed! (keeps in moisture and warmth)



All done, these will have the same thinning again later on, this will give me bigger and juicier fruit
