

Compost ready for sowing, multipurpose mixed with worm casts and vermiculite

Time to sow leeks for our bring and buys! Colley Gate Gardening Club and West Midlands DA of the NVS have bring and buys to raise money for their clubs – I do eating (not show) leeks from Wilko - I also do a larger tub of carrots for myself



8 pots of leeks done (1 packet per 4 tubs). Carrots sown thinly

All pots covered with vermiculite then watered with a fine spray so there's no disturbance!

I buy Epsom Salts bulk for our trading sheds - this one is from the chemist! I now water at 3 week intervals at 1 teaspoon to 4 pints - a good tonic!
