

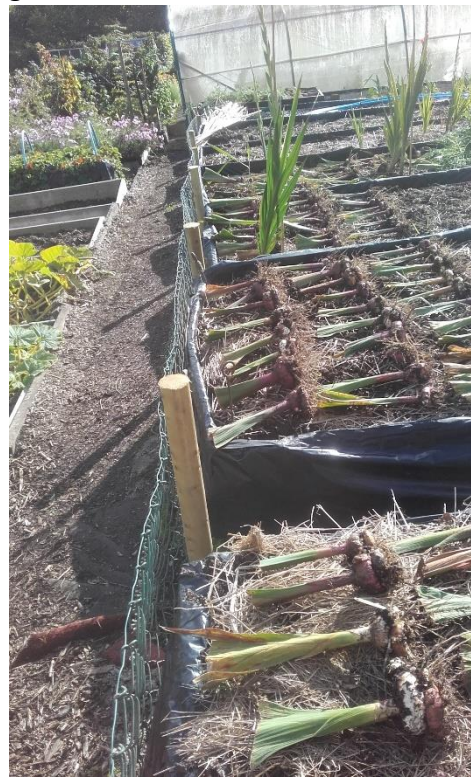
Gladioli are ready to come out

Homework; the new gardening year has started. I use plastic drinking cups for everything (Pound Shop), these are held firmly in a 15 tray insert inside a full size seed tray (not the flimsy ones!)



Capillary matting washed in a Jeyes fluid water mix, swilled out and dried on the line



Inside of propagator in the loft wiped down with Jeyes fluid, matting replaced, under soil warming cable and light ready, this comes into operation end of November with leeks, onions and peppers



Last of my large leeks up, only one thing to make a good stew with groats...which reminds me I haven't make groaty dick for a while (black country dish!)
