Peter has grown and shown Giant Vegetables for over 25 years with his wife Mary, exhibiting throughout Britain at many national shows. He has also entered and won a number of NVS national classes, including the NVS collection of 6 kinds of vegetables.

He has been extremely successful over this time with many World records, three of which are still held – heaviest carrot, cauliflower, and potato. Peter is also in the current Guinness World Record Book twice and has been seven times winner of the World Heaviest Onion competition.

The giant vegetables have created lots of media interest in newspapers, magazines and books. Peter has had TV garden visits by all the national/local channels as well as crews from around the world, such as Belgium, America, Australia, Turkey and Japan.

Peter has a large garden at home which helps to manage this 12 month, 24/7 hobby. Peter is a member of the NVS Northern Branch. During his talk Peter will share with us his approach to growing a variety of giant vegetables.
